One unit treats an entire room (Up to 20' x 25' with an 8' ceiling) [with an effective bug killing fog that leaves no unpleasant residual odor.]

For Use in Rooms, Apartments, Homes, Attics, Basements, Campers, Boats, Garages, Pet Sleeping Areas, Household Storage Areas, Cabins.

[When used as directed, it will not harm drapes, upholstery fabrics, carpeting, bedspreads, clothing, linens, furniture, walls, floor tiles, ceilings, shades or blinds.]

Kills flies, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets, and moths. Also kills roaches [cockroaches], spiders, water bugs, silverfish, ants and crickets.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. *For home use only.*

OPTION A

For use in Kitchen and Food Preparation Areas: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment and thoroughly washed after fogger use. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. **PUT OUT ALL FLAMES AND PILOT LIGHTS.**

Use one unit for each 4,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Do not use this can in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

TO OPERATE VALVE: Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. To lock valve button in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Turn on fans and air conditioners and open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or

OPTION B

For best results, treat all infested areas. Use one fogger for each 4,000 cubic feet (approximately 20 ft. x 25 ft. x 8 ft. ceiling) of unobstructed area. Use additional cans for remote rooms or where the free flow of fog is not assured. NOTE: Do not use more than one can per average size room. Do not use this can in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this can in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

PREPARATION

Remove or cover exposed food, dishes, utensils, surfaces and food-handling equipment. **PUT OUT ALL FLAMES AND PILOT LIGHTS.** Close outside doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Remove pets and birds. Cover or remove fish tanks and bowls. Open interior pantry and closet doors and cabinets of areas to be treated. Remove all infested food products and dispose of in outside trash. Leave rugs, draperies and upholstered furniture in place. This product will not harm furniture when used as directed. (Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger. Newspapers may be used.)

TO START FOGGING

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE USING



Hold can at arm's length with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks. This will start fogging action. Set can in an upright position on a table, stand, etc. (up to 30 inches in height in the center of the area) and place several thicknesses of newspaper under the can to prevent marring of the surface. For best results, treat the whole dwelling using multiple cans in homes with more than one level and numerous rooms. Leave the building at once.

AIRING OUT

DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR TWO HOURS. After two hours, open all outside doors and windows, turn on air conditioner and/or fans and let treated area air for 30 minutes before re-occupying. If additional cans are used for remote rooms or where free flow of fog is not assured, increase airing-out time accordingly. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Discard container in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
