Dear Mr. Gebken:

In response to the Agency's letter of November 29, 2004 (copy enclosed), enclosed please find our revised Notification to correct errors in the active ingredient statement for the subject product. Two mistakes were made when this label was submitted to update the First Aid and Disposal statements: 1) One of the active ingredients, *N-Octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide*, was inadvertently omitted, and 2) A footnote "Contains petroleum distillates" was inadvertently added.

We do not currently market this product so the most recent stamped label, dated December 18, 2002, was filed away and the mistake not noticed until we were recently reviewing the file.

Enclosed are two copies of corrected labeling along with a copy of the most recent stamped accepted label and the previous stamped accepted label for your reference. We are also taking this opportunity to adopt the common chemical name of one of the active ingredients, *Piperonyl butoxide*, per PR Notice 97-5.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notices 98-10 and 97-5 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notices 98-10 and 97-5 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
