The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the tetramethrin, PBO, and permethrin REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.






**Chemsico Wasp & Hornet Killer S** is designed to kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. This product also kills mud daubers.

### STOP. READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. *For outdoor use only.*

#### Use Restrictions

- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not apply when windy.
- Do not make applications during rain.
- Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff.
- Do not wet plants to the point of runoff or drip.

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- Barrier, perimeter, or band applications to soil or vegetation around structures up to a maximum of ten feet away from the building.

- Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surface (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Never use indoors. Do not apply to people or pets. Do not contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils with spray.

- Apply at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active. (graphic -sunset)
- Stand a safe distance from the nest. Don't stand directly underneath.
- Shake can well before each use. Aim spray away from person. Push button to

4. spray. (graphic - hand w/can) spray the nest until soaked. (graphic -nest) Chemsico's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.  
 5. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

**[TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS & YELLOW JACKETS]**

1. Spray 1 - 2 seconds, until surface is moist, to kill wasps, hornets, and yellow jackets under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes, and crevices or wherever else insects are noticed.
2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.
