OPTIONAL MARKETING LANGUAGE

Dust mites are microscopic pests that are a major component of common household dust. They live and breed in your carpet, upholstery, bedding and other dust collectors. This product controls dust mites that may cause allergies, asthma, hay fever, rhinitis, watery eyes and sneezing. One treatment lasts for up to 8 weeks [2 months] [60 days].



(STOP.) Read entire label before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Remove pets and cover fish tanks before using.

NOTE: Test on hidden surface of carpet and upholstery before using. If texture or color is affected, do not use.

[FOR DUST MITES (Dermatophagoides spp.)] UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE

Hold container upright and 8 - 10 inches away from item. Spray until surface is damp. Allow furniture to completely dry, then vacuum thoroughly using a micro-filtration or other high efficiency [vacuum] bag. *Do not use on delicate fabrics*.

CARPETS

Hold container upright and 12 - 18 inches away from item. Slightly overlap the spray to give total coverage. Allow carpet to completely dry, then vacuum thoroughly using a micro-filtration or other high efficiency [vacuum] bag. Using a fan may shorten drying time.

MATTRESSES AND BEDDING

Spray the entire mattress (top, bottom and sides) until damp, paying special attention to tufts and seams. Allow items to completely dry, then vacuum thoroughly using a micro-filtration or other high efficiency (vacuum) bag.

[HELPFUL HINTS]

- Vacuum weekly; Replace your vacuum bag often; Use micro-filtration (vacuum) bags.
- Vacuum furniture, curtains, rugs, carpeting, bedding and other dust catchers.
- 3. Lowering the humidity in your home with air conditioning and dehumidi-

fiers can help; dust mites thrive on high humidity.

4. Treat every 8 weeks [2 months] [60 days], if needed.]

NOTE: Test inconspicuous sample of fabric or rug for staining before overall use. Check carpot manufacturer's warranty, care and maintenance information before using product on your carpeting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Discard container in trash

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
