On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. **Make the following labeling changes:**
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 9688-159"
 - b) Please remove all non-flammability claims from your label. This includes, but is not limited to, "Non-flammable dry fogger", "Non-flammable", "Non-flammable formula-no need to extinguish pilot lights". You may not have a label claim of "Contains a non-flammable propellant". Total release foggers may make a claim of non-flammability only when the flash point of the product is greater than 350° F (177° C). The flashpoint of Chemsico Insecticide NT is not greater than 350°. If you choose to alter your formulation based on your correspondence (attached) you will need to resubmit new product chemistry information. You should be able to bridge your acute toxicity data, however you will need to request this and when we receive your revised basic CSF it will be submitted for toxicity review.

- c) Please remove the statement "Keeps on killing". This statement implies residual activity. Otherwise, please qualify, and submit or cite efficacy data to substantiate your claim.
- d) Please remove your "No odor" claim. Many people suffer from chemical sensitivities and would not find this claim accurate. Please also remove your "No unpleasant odor" claim. You may substitute this with a "Low odor" claim, if you wish.
- e) Please remove your "Advanced technology" and "Premium" claims, per 40 CFR 156.10 (a) (5). You may retain the statement "New" technology on labeling produced for a period of 6 months following the date of issuance of registration.
- f) Please revise your "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" statement as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking chewing gum or using tobacco. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- g) Please revise your First Aid statement in accordance with PR Notice 2000-3:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
