DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. *For home lawn use only.*



Keep people (other than applicator) or pets off treated areas until spray has dried.

WHEN TO USE

This product is highly effective when it is used to prevent diseases, or applied at the first sign of disease. Start treating when grass begins to turn green in the spring or when signs of diseases are first noticed. For best disease control, treat every 2 weeks.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply more than 13 treatments per year. In Nassau and Suffolk Counties in New York state, do not apply more than 3

times per given area per year.

Do not treat lawns during periods of stress, i.e. heat, drought, flooding, insects, excessive fertilizer, herbicides or pesticide use, etc.

Do not apply when temperatures are above 85F as injury to lawn can occur.

If it rains before product has dried re-apply.

If you need more information, contact your local County Extension Service.

HOW TO USE

Determine the size of the area (lawn) to be treated. To calculate square feet, multiply length by width.

Start at the farthest point to be treated and work backward so you don't walk over treated area. Walk at a steady pace and spray using a side to side [arc] motion, slightly overlapping the treated area.

The entire [32 oz.] bottle will treat 3,000 sq. ft. of lawn. Refer to [sight gauge] [Easy-View [Clear-View] measuring window] to guide coverage (when bottle is half empty, you should have covered half the area).

ENTIRE LAWN

[HOW TO USE HOSE-END SPRAYER]

1. **Shake container well before using.**
2. Connect a garden hose to the spray ready nozzle. [graphic] Make sure the large round water control dial on the nozzle is in the "OFF" position (tab is vertical). [graphic]
3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area of lawn to be treated.

Twist the small star-shaped product control button to align the flat portion with the lock tab. Push the button in to open. [graphic]
4. To BEGIN spraying, point nozzle towards lawn and turn the large round water control dial to the "ON" position (tab is horizontal). Water will automatically mix with the

product. [graphic]

5. Walk at a steady pace while spraying the area.
6. To STOP spraying turn large round water control dial to the "OFF" position. Push in opposite side of small star-shaped product control button to close. Turn star-shaped button so that it is no longer aligned with the flat portion of the lock tab. Turn off water at faucet.
To relieve pressure, turn large round water control dial to "ON" position and wait until water stops spraying before removing nozzle from hose.
7. To STORE unused product, place in cool area away from heat, direct sunlight or open flame. KEEP FROM FREEZING.

Rainproof – rain or watering 2 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness. [If rainfall occurs within 2 hours of application, the product should be re-applied.]

NOTE: This product is non-staining to most homo siding depending on age and cleanliness. However, before using in areas where the spray may contact home siding (vinyl siding in particular), test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours. Do not use if any staining is observed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

ALTERNATE HOSE-END SPRAYER DIRECTIONS

1. Shake well before using.
2. Connect attached spray nozzle to garden hose. Turn the water control "ON/OFF" valve on top of nozzle to the "OFF" position.
3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area of lawn to be treated.
4. Rotate the product control valve forward to open. This allows the contents to mix with water.
5. To begin spraying, point nozzle towards lawn and turn the water control valve to the "ON" position. The water automatically mixes with the product.
6. Walk at a steady pace while spraying using an even side-

to-side sweeping motion, slightly overlapping treated areas. The entire [32 oz.] bottle will treat 3,000 sq.ft. of lawn. Refer to [sight gauge] [Easy-View] [Clear-View] measuring window] to guide coverage (when bottle is half-empty, you should have covered half the area).

7. To stop spraying, turn the water control valve to "OFF". Rotate the product control valve to upright position to close. To relieve pressure, turn water "ON/OFF" valve to the "ON" position before removing nozzle from hose.
8. To STORE unused product, place in cool area away from heat, direct sunlight or open flame. KEEP FROM FREEZING.
