DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For home lawn use only.



Keep people (other than applicator) or pets off treated areas until spray has dried.

WHEN TO USE

This product is highly effective when it is used to prevent diseases or applied at the first sign of disease. Start treating when grass begins to turn green in the spring or when signs of diseases are first noticed. For best disease control, treat every 2 weeks.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply more than 13 treatments per year. In Nassau and Suffolk Counties in New York State, do not apply more than 3 times per given area per year.

Do not treat lawns during periods of stress, i.e. heat, drought, flooding, insects, excessive fertilizer, herbicides or pesticide use, etc.

Do not apply when temperatures are above 85°F as injury to lawn can occur.

If it rains before product has dried, reapply.

If you need more information, contact your local County Extension Service.

HOW TO USE

Determine the size of the area (lawn) to be treated. To calculate square feet, multiply length by width.

Start at the farthest point to be treated and work backward so you don't walk over treated area. Walk at a steady pace and spray using a side-to-side [arc] motion, slightly overlapping the treated area.

The entire [32 oz] bottle will treat 3,000 sq ft of lawn. Refer to [sight gauge] [Easy-View] [Clear-View] measuring window to guide coverage. When bottle is half empty, you should have covered half the area.

ENTIRE LAWN

HOSE END SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS [Dial Button]

- 1. Shake container well before using.
- Connect a garden hose to the Ready Spray nozzle. Make sure the dial on the nozzle is in the "OFF" position with the [green] safety tab in the valve notch.
- 3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area to be treated and work back toward the faucet so you don't come in contact with the treated area.

- 4. To BEGIN spraying, point nozzle toward lawn or plants to be treated and 1.) bend the [green] safety tab (located at right of [yellow] dial) back and hold, 2.) using your other hand, QUICKLY turn the dial clockwise until it stops and [green] tab engages into notch. Water will automatically mix with the product.
- 5. Spray lawn or plants thoroughly. Walk at a steady pace while spraying using an even sweeping motion, slightly overlapping treated areas. One quart will treat 3,000 sq ft. Calculate square feet by multiplying length by width. Refer to sight gauge to guide coverage (example: when bottle is half empty, you should have covered half the area).
- 6. To STOP spraying, QUICKLY turn the dial in the opposite direction of "ON" (counter clockwise) until it stops and the safety tab engages into the notch. Turn water off at faucet. To relieve pressure before removing nozzle from hose, bend the safety tab back and turn dial "ON" until water stops spraying.
- To STORE unused product, make sure the dial is in the "OFF" position with the green safety tab in the valve notch. Place in a cool area away from heat, sunlight or open flame.

Rainproof – rain or watering 2 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness. [If rainfall occurs within 2 hours of application, the product should be reapplied.]

NOTE: This product is non-staining to most home siding depending on age and cleanliness. However, before using in areas where the spray may contact home siding (vinyl siding in particular), test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours. Do not use if any staining is observed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Please find enclosed notification per PR Notice 98-10 to correct the statement of coverage in Step 5 of the hose end sprayer directions to read "3,000 sq ft" instead of "5,000 sq ft". We would also like to take this opportunity to correct the inadvertent insect reference also located in Step 5 of the hose end sprayer directions, to read, "Spray lawn or plants thoroughly," in addition to correcting formatting inconsistencies.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
