HOW TO USE

Do not use kitchen utensils as measuring devices.

- Mix 0.5 fl. oz. (1 Tablespoon) with 1 gallon of water
- Apply solution as a gentle rain to each fire ant mound using a sprinkler can.
- Thoroughly wet the mound and surrounding area to a 4 foot diameter.
- Treat new mounds as they appear.
- Larger quantities of solution can be prepared for multiple mound treatments. Equipment to deliver the diluted product as a gentle rain at the rate of 1 gallon per mound is still required.
- Do not use equipment that produces a pressurized spray as pressurized sprays may disturb fire ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

[OPTIONAL USE DIRECTIONS FOR TIP-N-MEASURE BOTTLE]

- With both caps tightened on bottle, tip the bottle to one side to allow product to flow into measuring portion of bottle neck (side without printed measurements).
- Tip bottle in opposite direction (toward side with printed measurements) until desired amount of product is measured (0.5 oz/gallon of water)
- Remove cap from measured portion and add to water.

[USE TIPS

- For best results apply in cool weather, 65°- 80° F, or in early morning or late evening hours. At these times, fire ants are closer to the surface virtually assuring the product will contact them.
- If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity, and treat all colonies which may not as yet have constructed a mound.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
