The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated November 28, 2011



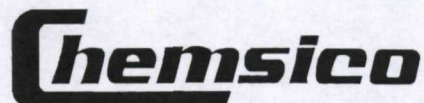

1. Chemsico Fire Ant Killer PD is tracked deep into the mound by worker ants.
2. In 3-7 days the fire ants are dead.]

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.



Allow dust to settle in treated areas before re-entering.

Precautions and Restrictions

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before treatment.

- Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.
- Do not make applications during rain.
- All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:
 1. Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures
 2. Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation

- All outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.
- Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

HOW TO USE

[TO APPLY AS A SHAKER: Hold container 12-18" above mound. Tilt to use multiple holes, shake gently and sprinkle evenly over the mound. Use 1 Tbsp. [3 shakes] per mound. (For mounds larger than 8" use 2 Tbsp.)]

TO MEASURE AND APPLY: Sprinkle 1 Tablespoon of dry powder over each mound. For large (8" or more in diameter) mounds apply 2 Tablespoons.

Try not to disturb mound during application.

Do not water in. [This is important as it allows fire ant workers to] [Alternate: Fire ant workers will] track the powder deep into the mound. Fire Ant Killer PD starts to work upon contact, though mound kill is not immediate.

For best results, apply in morning or evening hours. At these times, fire ants are closer to the surface virtually assuring the product will contact them. Chemsico Fire Ant Killer PD will kill the fire ants in 3-7 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. **Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: If empty:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in

trash or offer for recycling, if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
