2. Submit an acceptable enforcement analytical method (Guideline 830.6317) for the active ingredient, prallethrin. EPA acknowledges receipt of revised methodology (submitted October 9; MRID # as yet unassigned) to fulfill this requirement. EPA will review the revised method to determine whether it is acceptable and will advise you of our determination once the review is completed.
