The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Prallethrin and Lambda-cyhalothrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT apply directly to residential lawns and turf in residential settings (e.g., homes, parks, schools, athletic fields or any other area frequented by the general public).

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, and othervegetation;
- 2. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or structure;
- 3. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 4. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, mulch or vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

- 1. Apply at sunset when insects are least active (graphic-sunset)
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Don't stand directly underneath.
- 3. Shake can well before each use. Aim spray away from person. Push button to spray. (graphic-hand w/can)
- 4. Spray the nest until soaked. (graphic-nest). Chemsico's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest over the next few days.
- 5. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

Tent Caterpillars: Apply in the late afternoon or evening when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Soak tents on all sides. **Scorpions:** Stand at a safe distance and use the power of the jet spray to reach and cover the scorpion. **Ants:** Spray trails, nest and point of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. **Disposal**: Do not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty**: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled**: Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer.
