Your submission dated February 26, 2007

The labeling, referred to above, submitted in connection with the application under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the following changes:

A. For all labels

2. Under "Environmental Hazards";

Add "or rinsate" after "washwaters."

2. Under "Directions for Use":

Specify that the annual maximum application rate is 0.23 lb prometon per 500 ft² or the equivalent area you're using.

3. Under "Storage and Disposal";

Add instructions for container disposal.

B. For Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P (EPA Reg. No. 9688-192)

3. Under the Heading:

Add a weight of prometon per gallon statement.

4. Under "Directions for Use";

Add the following spray drift management statement:

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"Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals."

3. Under "When to Apply";

The maximum application limit for prometon is 0.23 pound per 500 ft² per year. It converts to 0.115 lb per 100 ft², 0.46 lb per 1,000 ft², or 20.04 lbs per acre. Your high application rate is 72 fl. oz. per 100 ft². Assuming the product contains 0.18 lb prometon per gallon, it converts to an application rate of 44.1 lbs of prometon/acre. (72 /128 x 0.18 x 43560 / 100). It has exceeded the maximum application rate of 20.04 lbs per acre. You need to reduce the high application rates within the application limit.

6. Under "Personal Protective Equipment";

Add a section on personal protective equipment with following requirements:

- · Long sleeved shirt and long pants.
- Shoes and socks.
- Chemical resistant gloves made of waterproof materials such as butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, or neoprene rubber (≥ 14 mils).
- 7. Under "Storage and Disposal";

Change "Storage" to "Pesticide storage" and "disposal" to "Pesticide Disposal."

The amended label supersedes all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of the revised label is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

[GENERAL INFORMATION] [HOW TO USE] [THINGS TO KNOWI

Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P is a nonselective product intended for use after dilution with water and will kill almost all vegetation down to the roots and prevent plant regrowth. When applied to the soil this product can inhibit plant growth for up to one year. Residual control increases as rates are increased.

[USE SITES]

- Use around the home where no plant growth is desired.
- [Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P is intended] for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, sidewalks, brick walks, paths, patios, parking areas, play

where plant growth has come through these surfaces.

Do not use on lawns, flowerbeds, or vegetable gardens. Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P should not be applied over the root zones of desirable trees or shrubs. Do not apply in sloped areas where runoff may adversely affect desirable plants.

For Best Results: Although Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through roots; therefore, its effectiveness is dependent on rainfall to move it into the root zone. Very dry soil conditions and lack of sufficient rainfall may result in poor weed control. For best results, if the soil is dry, water lightly before treatment. Apply Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate P directly to weeds and grass. Thoroughly wet weeds but do not soak as runoff may occur. Two days following application, lightly water the treated area. This will aid in the killing and prevention of weeds through root absorption.

WHEN TO APPLY

- For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting.
- Weeds taller than 4 inches should be hoed or cut to 1 inch in height before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application.
- A second application may also be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds. In areas of heavy rainfall, repeat application may be required every six months.

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds, use the lower rates listed below. For control of hard-to-kill perennial broadleaf and grass weeds, use the higher rates listed in the table [below].

| 100 sq. ft. | 1 pt (16 fl. oz.) | 2 qt. 8 fl. oz. (72 fl. oz.) | 2 gallon |

Apply using a sprinkling can or other watering or spraying device in sufficient water to get good coverage of the area (refer to suggested amount of water to use in above table.) When using a sprinkling can, triple rinse and pour rinsewater on area treated once application is complete. Mix only the quantity needed and use immediately. Do not store diluted solution.

IMPORTANT USE PRECAUTIONS:

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- To avoid damage to desirable plants, apply when it is not windy. Windy conditions may cause inadvertent drifting to desirable plants and grass.
- DO NOT apply over the root zones of desirable trees and shrubs.
- DO NOT apply to decorative rock or bark groundcovers where the soil is covered with plastic fabric or on slopes because runoff and/or leaching may result (apply only to level surfaces). In heavy clay soil locations, residual activity may exceed one year.
- DO NOT apply closer than twice the distance from the trunk of a tree to the drip line.
- Do not apply next to a fence if desirable plants are growing on the other side or if future plantings are planned.
- · Vertically cut through any roots adjacent to root zone of desirable plants.
- It is advisable to wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes when applying this product. Wash contaminated clothing after use, separately from other family laundry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store undiluted pesticide in original container. Do not store dituted pesticide solution. Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
