We can revisit a fast kill or 24-hour claim after receipt of acceptable data. We ask that you do a lab test, comparing efficacy to fipronil, another quick kill compound, and demonstrate at least 90% kill in 24 hours.

- b. Delete the claims "Attractant draws roaches to the bait station", "The bait draws roaches" and "...attracting roaches to the bait tray". No data on the bait matrix was submitted. Data are required demonstrating this bait is attractant to cockroaches in order to support the label claims.
- c. Delete the claims, "...or come in contact with the bait", "roaches die whether or not they eat from the bait station" and "kills roaches remaining in the nest". These claims are too broad.
- 4. Within 6 months from the date of this letter, submit field efficacy data to verify the application rate, i.e., 10 bait stations for the kitchen, and 2 for the bathroom.
  - 5. Provide information on different sizes that you mention in the Master Label statement.
- 6. Submit production information (gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which this use is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 30. The production information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year.
