The label amendment to indicate quick kill and kills in (24) hours, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1. Submitted data supports a quick kill claim only against the most common species of cockroach, the German cockroach. Therefore, add a statement to the label indicating that all quick kill, kills within hours, or kills within 24-hours claims are for the German or small cockroach.
- 2. Please submit an efficacy study on a large species of cockroach, the American cockroach. Upon submission and review of acceptable efficacy data for the large or American cockroach, you can remove the statement required above.
- 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment:

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
