Name of Pesticide Product: Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with Section 3(c)(7) of the Federal Insecticide, fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, provided you submit acceptable one year storage stability and corrosion characteristics studies within 18 months of the date of this registration.

Make the following label changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- 1. Add a statement of the weight of active ingredients per gallon of product.
- 2. Follow the directions in Chapter 3 of the <u>EPA Label Review Manual</u> for proper sizing of the "Signal Word" and ""Keep out of Reach of Children." (Refer to EPA's web site: http://www.epa.gov/oppfod01/labeling/lrm/index.html for information).
- 3. Revise the "First Aid Statements" to be in accordance with EPA PR Notice 2001-1. The sequence of treatments is based on the toxicological effects of the route of entry.
- 4. Under "Precautionary Statements":

Move this paragraph above the "Directions for Use" paragraph. Replace the sentence "Avoid contact with skin and clothing" with "Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing."

- 5. Add a section on "Personal Protective Equipment" with the following requirements:
 - Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
 - Chemical resistant gloves made of waterproof materials, such as butyl rubber ≥ 14 mils, nitrile rubber ≥ 14 mils, or neoprene rubber ≥ 14 mils.
 - Shoes and socks.
- 6. Add the following "Spray Drift Management" Statements:

"Do not allow spray to drift from the application site and contact people, structures people occupy at any time and the associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals."

7. Under "When to Apply":

You specify two application rates (lower and higher). For the Prometon, the application rates are 9.6 lbs. and 48 lbs. AI /acre for the lower rate and higher rate respectively. For the diquat dibromide, the application rates are 3.1 lbs. and 15.5 lbs. AI /acre for the lower rate and higher rate respectively. Based on the review of other product labels containing diquat dibromide, the maximum application rate is 3.5 lbs. AI /acre. For the labels containing Prometon, the maximum application rate is 20 lbs. AI / acre. The higher application rates need to be deleted unless you have documentation to justify these application rates.

8. Under "Important User Precautions";

Add the following statements:

"Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Only persons apply this product may be in the area during application."

Under "Storage and Disposal";

Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" and "Disposal" to "Pesticide Disposal."

10. Under "Notice":

The Agency has not reviewed or accepted the liability statement. It may need to be changed at a later date.

11. Make the following label changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

Add on the front panel, "EPA Reg. No. 9668-198" and "EPA Est. No. 9668-XX-XX."

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

[GENERAL INFORMATION] [HOW TO USE] [THINGS TO KNOW!

Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP is a nonselective product intended for use after dilution with water and will kill almost all vegetation down to the roots and prevent plant regrowth. When applied to the soil this product can inhibit plant growth for up to one year. Residual control increases as rates are increased.

[USE SITES]

- Use around the home where no plant growth is desired.
- [Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP is intended] for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, sidewalks, brick walks, paths, patios, parking areas, play areas, along fences and curbs, around buildings, and graveled pathways where plant growth has come through these surfaces.

Do not use on lawns, flowerbeds, or vegetable gardens. Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP should not be applied over the root zones of desirable trees or shrubs. Do not apply in sloped areas where runoff may adversely affect desirable plants.

For Best Results: Although Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through roots; therefore, its effectiveness is dependent on rainfall to move it into the root zone. Very dry soil conditions and lack of sufficient rainfall may result in poor weed control. For best results, if the soil is dry, water lightly before treatment. Apply Chemsico Herbicide Concentrate DP directly to weeds and grass. Thoroughly wet weeds but do not soak as runoff may occur. Two days following application, lightly water the treated area. This will aid in the killing and prevention of weeds through root absorption.

WHEN TO APPLY

- · For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting.
- Weeds taller than 4 inches should be hoed or cut to 1 inch in height before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application.
- A second application may also be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds. In areas of heavy rainfall, repeat application may be required every six months.
- Application on sunny days with the temperature above 60° F will result in faster control of existing weeds.

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds, use the lower rates listed below. For control of hard-to-kill perennial broadleaf and grass weeds, use the higher rates listed in the table [below].

Apply using a sprinkling can or other watering or spraying device in sufficient water to get good coverage of the area (refer to suggested amount of water to use in above table.) When using a sprinkling can, triple rinse and pour rinsewater on area treated once application is complete. Mix only the quantity needed and use immediately. Do not store diluted solution.

IMPORTANT USE PRECAUTIONS:

- To avoid damage to desirable plants, apply when it is not windy. Windy conditions may cause inadvertent drifting to desirable plants and grass.
- DO NOT apply over the root zones of desirable trees and shrubs.
- DO NOT apply to decorative rock or back groundcovers where the soil is covered with prastic tabric or on singles because runoff and/or leaching may result (apply only to level surfaces). In heavy clay soil locations, residual activity may exceed one year.

- DO NOT apply closer than twice the distance from the trunk of a tree to the drip line.
- Do not apply next to a fence if desirable plants are growing on the other side or if future plantings are planned.
- Vertically cut through any roots adjacent to root zone of desirable plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store-undiluted pesticide in original container. Do not store diluted pesticide solution. Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
