Dear Ms. Goldberg:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable under the following conditions:

- Because this amendment involves adding an additional packaging type which is different than that utilized for the original registration, you must submit storage stability and corrosion characteristics data (Guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320). You have 18 months from the date of this letter to submit these data.


In addition, please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself. This information can be added by non-notification per PR Notice 98-10.

Please also note that should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website (www.hotshot.com, www.tatkillsbugs.com, www.spectracide.com) on your label, then the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, *regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label*, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website may be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Per 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6), submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. As defined in 40 CFR 152.3, "final printed labeling" means the "label or labeling of the product when distributed or sold." Clearly legible reproductions or photo reductions will be accepted for unusual labels. Note that a clean copy of the master label in most cases does not meet the definition of final printed labeling. In this case, because your product is distributed in different packaging types, please submit final printed labeling for all packaging types.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). [Scout ants seeking food for their colony find the bait station and begin feeding. They take the bait back to the colony where it is eaten by both the queen and other worker ants. The colony stops reproducing and begins to die, preventing ants from the colony from infesting your home.]

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Option A: Label Directions for bait stations:

INDOORS [INDOOR USE]

1. Open pouch [and break bait stations apart from each other.]

2. Place one bait station along each ant trail or in out-of-the-way places near walls, in cabinets, and under sinks and refrigerators. Heavily infested areas may require two or more bait stations for effective control.

3. For continued indoor control, replace baits every 6 months, or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty
[Alternate: Replace baits every six months for continued indoor control or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty.]

OUTDOORS [OUTDOOR USE] (*Optional Directions for bait stations or stakes*)

1. Open pouch [package] [and break baits apart before using].
2. Place one bait [station] [stake into the ground] along each ant trail around the outside of homes. Place [stations][stakes] in areas inaccessible to children, pets and other non-target animals. Larger homes or homes with heavy infestations may require two or more bait [stations] [stakes] to achieve control.

3. For continued outdoor control replace baits every 3 months or sooner if infestation is heavy [or bait station is empty]. [Alternate: Replace baits every 3 months for continued indoor control or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty.]

(Option B: label directions for the metal can packaging

Note to Reviewer: These directions are not CRP Certified)

1. Find indented sections on the sides of the can.
2. Simply apply pressure with key until they open [see illustration]
3. **Indoors:** Place one bait station along each ant trail or in out-of-the-way places near walls, in cabinets, and under sinks and refrigerators. Heavily infested areas may require two or more bait stations for effective control. [Optional graphic showing bait placement]
4. For continued indoor control, replace baits every 6 months, or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty
[Alternate: Replace baits every six months for continued indoor control or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty.]
5. **Outdoors:** Place one bait station along each ant trail around the outside of homes. Place stations in areas inaccessible to children, pets and other non-target animals. Larger homes or homes with heavy infestations may require two or more bait stations to achieve control. [Optional graphic showing bait placement]
6. For continued outdoor control replace baits every 3 months or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty. [Alternate: Replace baits every 3

months for continued indoor control or sooner if infestation is heavy or bait station is empty.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
