USE TIPS

- (graphic) For best results, apply in early Spring or Summer at the first sign of Fire Ant activity to prevent mounds from forming.
- 2. Apply in the early morning or late evening when fire ants are actively foraging.
- 3. Do not apply if rain is expected within 4-6 hours.
- 4. Do not water or mow treated area for 24 hours after application. This will allow time for the ants to forage the bait and take it to the mound.
- 5. Treating the entire yard is recommended since it will kill foraging ants and mounds which may not be visible at the time of application.
- 6. People and pets may re-enter treated area immediately after broadcast.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Reclose bag tightly after each use. Store in a cool, dry area which is inaccessible to children and pets. If Empty: Do not reuse this container.
