b. **Precautionary Statements:**

Revise the statement "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco".

- c. **Physical or Chemical Hazards:** Add "*Extremely flammable*". The cited data (MRID #434993-01) from the "me-too" product EPA Reg. No. 73049-160 indicates a flash point of 192°F, with flame extension and flash back of 28 and 2.5 inches, respectively.
- d. On the front panel, delete the claim "*no faster knockdown available*". False or misleading comparison to other pesticides is not acceptable.
- e. Add a single and double asterisk to the active ingredients "Permethrin" and "Piperonyl Butoxide", respectively, and add the following corresponding statements directly beneath the ingredient statement:
**Cis/trans ratio: min. 35% (+/-) cis and max. 65% (+/-) trans.*
***Equivalent to min. 0.6% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.15% related compounds.*
3. Submit to the Agency, data on one year storage stability testing (830.6317), conducted concurrently with the corrosion characteristics study (830-6320) at 0, 3, 6, 9 and 12 months of warehouse storage.
4. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the above stated revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. *For use around the home only.*

For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. [Remove protective cap.] Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill wasps, hornets and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry area away from children. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
