- b. The data submitted supports only a "kills" claim. Therefore delete residual and duration claims throughout the labeling. Also delete the term "Control" in the product name.

- c. The data submitted did not support kill/control of the following pests: ticks, brown dog ticks, scorpions, and tree termites. Therefore, remove any and all pests except the following: ants, cockroaches, fleas, mosquitoes, spiders, crickets, earwigs, silverfish, firebrats, and other pests, NOT of public health importance. Additional data, which satisfy the standards for inclusion of pests of public health importance, must be submitted or cited. Refer to the enclosed efficacy review for specific deficiencies associated with the data submitted.
- d. Remove drywood termites from the label. As presented the directions for use against drywood termites imply residual activity of the product, which has not been demonstrated. Efficacy has been demonstrated only when the product is directly applied to exposed drywood termites.

Note that based on a Toxicity Category 4 classification for this product you are not required to carry hazards to humans and domestic animals, first aid or the signal word caution.

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

4. You must generate and submit the studies for one year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320). It is recommended that the observations be made at time intervals of 0,3,6,9, and 12 months. The corrosion characteristics study can be conducted simultaneously with the one year storage stability study.

INDOORS (Graphic showing Indoor treatment sites.)

For Drywood Termites [polillas] treat infested areas and areas likely to be infested, such as wood surfaces, voids and tunnels [channels] in damaged wood, behind veneers, in structural voids (between stud walls and spaces between wood and concrete [foundations] and along cracks. When treating for exposed drywood termites pay particular attention to areas around windows, ventilation pipes and other areas that may allow termite entry into the home.

Note: Drywood termites will be killed only if they come in contact with this product. Use of this product to control drywood termites should not be considered as a substitute for treatment by a professional pest control operator.



Spray areas where cockroaches, Palmetto bugs, ants, crickets, water bugs, silverfish and spiders are found or normally occur including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations. Repeat application after eight weeks or earlier if re-infestation occurs. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows and wherever else ants may find entrance.

For Tree termites (spp. Nasutitermes)[comejenes] treat specific areas where termite trails and nests are seen. Make holes in the nest and apply enough product to saturate the nest. Thoroughly wet termite trails going into the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing treated nest.
