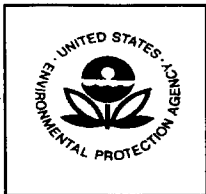

2) Per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals must be revised to read:

3) Per the Diquat RED, the text “This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates” must be added to the Environmental Hazard section of the label.

5) To the Storage and Disposal section change “Storage” to “Pesticide Storage” and “Disposal” to “Pesticide Disposal”.

6) Place the First Aid section within a box.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Only persons applying this product may be in the area during application.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Clothing and protective equipment exposed to this product should be washed in detergent and hot water. Such items should be kept and washed separately from other laundry.

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

[When to Apply] [Use Tips]

- For best results apply during warm, sunny weather (above 60°F) when weeds are actively growing and no rain is forecast for 24 hours. Rainfall or watering 15 minutes after application will not wash away effectiveness.
- To avoid drift to desirable plants, apply when the air is calm.

Not recommended for spot weed treatment in established lawns since lawn grasses will also be killed.
