On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you:

You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

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b. Change "Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor or going for treatment." to "HOT LINE NUMBER: Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical information. Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillates- vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.".

c. The Agency is recommending that an "If Swallowed" statement be added to the First Aid section. The agency understands that, based on the method of application, it is unlikely that someone would swallow any of this product. We additionally understand that this product is category IV for primary acute oral toxicity. However, based on the petroleum distillate concentration of this product, in the unlikely event that some of the product is swallowed, special precautions would be needed to be observed. A "Note to Physician" is required, based on the petroleum distillate concentration.

d. Based on the acute toxicity profile you may delete the IF IN EYES and corresponding precautions, "causes moderate eye irritation".

e. Residual control claims are not supported by these data. The data support the addition of the following pests with a "Kills" performance claim: Cockroaches, fleas, (adults only) black carpenter ants, spiders, moths, crickets, brown dog ticks, waterbugs, earwigs, palmetto bugs, pillbugs, black carpet beetles, rice weevils and saw tooth grain beetles.

f. Please submit or cite data for silverfish and/or firebrats.

g. Please qualify the ant species to be kill or excluded from use or delete. Public health species require testing.

h. Remove the claim "flying insects" because none were tested. No data was cited or submitted to support this claim.

i. Add "or stored" to the end of the sentence, "... commercially prepared, processed or stored.".

j. Delete the marketing claim, "Dead On... Every Time". Implied claims of heightened efficacy are not acceptable .

3. You must generate studies corresponding to guidelines 830.6317 (one year storage stability) and 830.6320 (corrosion characteristics). You are required to generate the one year storage stability study under warehouse conditions. The observations must be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months intervals. The corrosive characteristic study may be carried at concurrently. The results must be submitted to the Agency along with and electronic format also.

4. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Cover or removed exposed food, dishes and food preparation equipment. Open cabinets and doors. Shut off fans and air conditioners and turn off all ignition sources as directed above. Remove pets including birds. Cover and turn off fish tanks. Close outside doors and windows.

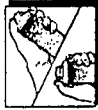


TO START FOGGING

1. Place several layers of newspaper or paper towels on a table, stand or floor in center of room. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger. Newspapers may be used.



2. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.** Tilt can top away from face. Press valve all the way down, hooking the catch.



3. Set can on newspaper or paper towels and leave the premises immediately. Do not re-enter treated area for two hours.

AIRING OUT

After two hours, open all doors and windows, turn on air conditioner and fans and air out for 30 minutes. Re-apply every two to four weeks if needed.

NOTE: When treating for fleas or ticks, clean and treat pet sleeping areas. Also treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter the treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **Disposal:** If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
