- d. Change the order of the First Aid statements to “If on Skin or Clothing” then “If in Eyes”.
- e. It is recommended that an emergency contact number be included in the First Aid section.
- f. The Environmental Hazards section text should be revised as per PR Notice 2008-1.
- g. On page 3 under Mixing Instructions, change the text to read “Food utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups **must** not be used for food purposes after use with pesticides.”
- h. Change the heading from “Pesticide Disposal” to “Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling” and change the text to read “Nonrefillable container.
