Do not place this [ready-to-use] [refillable] [reusable] bait station in any area where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into direct contact with food.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS** Determine areas where rats [and house mice] will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rats [and house mice] or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food, water, and harborage as possible prior to bait application.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS** The active ingredient in this product is different from anticoagulant rodenticides. Individual Norway and Roof rats [and house mice] cease feeding after consuming a toxic dose.

**Norway and Roof Rats** Place the bait station in areas where Norway and Roof rats or their signs have been seen. If additional units are to be used, place bait stations 20 to 30 feet apart. Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait placements and replace with new bait at sites where there is heavy feeding or where there is continued evidence of rat activity. Continue baiting until all signs of Norway and Roof rat activity have ceased.

**[House Mice]** Place the bait station in areas where house mice or their signs have been seen. If additional units are to be used, place bait stations 8 to 12 feet apart. Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait placements and replace with new bait at sites where there is heavy feeding or where there is continued evidence of house mouse activity. Continue baiting until all signs of house mouse activity have ceased.]



While wearing waterproof gloves, collect and properly dispose of all dead rats [and house mice] and used baits. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If re-infestation does occur, repeat treatment.

1. To open the Bait Station, put on waterproof gloves and push down and turn cap counter-clockwise to remove.



2. If refilling, discard any remaining bait in the bait station. Place [4] refill blocks on the pin in the center of the bait station opening.



3. Replace cap and turn clockwise to re-secure cap.
