Three Easy Steps to Use this Product

Step #1: Determine size of job, measure the area to be treated

Step #2: Use spreader setting chart to determine the appropriate setting for your spreader.

Step #3: Treat as indicated in the rate chart. Thorough coverage is important. Water in granules immediately after application

Note:

- · Do not apply more than 3 times per year per location
- Do not allow product to run off from target site or apply within 24 hours of rain.
- •Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to an area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

WHEN TO USE

This product is highly effective when it is used to prevent listed fungi and the lawn diseases they cause. Start treating when grass begins to turn green in the spring or when signs of lawn diseases caused by the listed fungi and insect damage are first noticed. For best control treat every two weeks.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply Chemsico Pesticide Granules PL II at a rate of 4 pounds/1000 sq ft over the area to be treated using a properly calibrated drop or rotary-type spreader when conditions are favorable for disease development according to the manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to make sure the spreader is operating properly and distributing product evenly. A more uniform application may be achieved by spreading half of the required amount of product over the area and then applying the remaining half in swaths at a right angle to the first. Avoid skips and excessive overlaps during application. Water lawn after application.
