WHERE TO USE

To Kill Fleas, spray infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and

localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Test inconspicuous sample of fabric or rug for staining before use. Old bedding of pets should be removed and cleaned or replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. **Do not treat pets with this product.** To control the source of flea infestations, treat your pet with a product registered for animal application. Also treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

To Kills Dust Mites: Thoroughly vacuum entire room, concentrating on areas where dust mites congregate such as headboards, walls, floors, carpeting and baseboards. Apply as a crack and crevice treatment to those areas.
