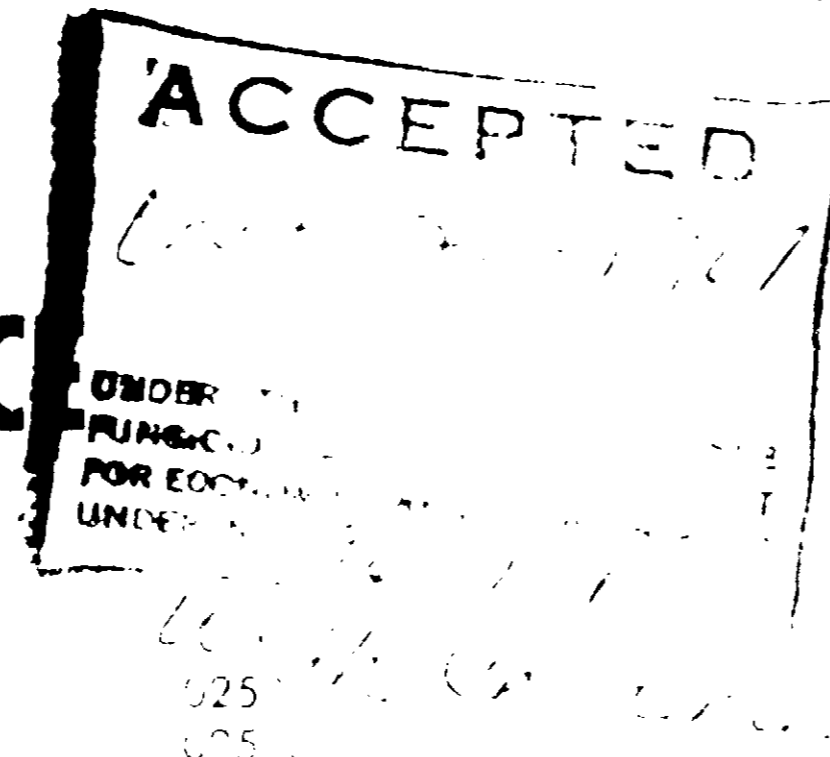

CAUTION: Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets.

DIRECTIONS: Rats Place 4 ounces or more of WAY PROLIN BAIT in tamper-proof bait boxes or under debris not accessible to children, domestic animals or pets. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 10 days.

Mice Tablespoon amounts of WAY PROLIN BAIT should be placed at 2-foot intervals in tamper-proof bait boxes or under debris not accessible to children, domestic animals or pets. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days.

Note: Baiting should continue until a lack of feeding is noticed. To control reinfestation, keep fresh WAY PROLIN BAIT continuously in protected areas inhabited by rats and mice. Contaminated or spoiled baits should be replaced promptly.

ANTIDOTE: Give a tablespoonful of water or milk if water is not available and if vomit fluid is clear. Call a Physician immediately. If swallowed by humans, dogs, cats, animals or pets, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such cases, intravenous calcium gluconate or calcium chloride combined with blood transfusions may be helpful. For information on the toxicity of 3-(o-acetylphenyl)-4-hydroxycoumarin.
