WARNING: Convulsive Poison! Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Keep away from children and domestic animals. Poisonous if Swallowed! Wash hands after using. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with waste.

DIRECTIONS: Hand Baiting - Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan-shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a shovel and a long-handled spoon carefully remove the plug and clean out lateral runway down to the junction with the main underground tunnel. Insert a teaspoonful of WAY POCKET GOPHER BAIT at the junction of the lateral with the main underground tunnel. Reclose opening without covering bait in tunnel. Use rubber gloves to distribute this material. Machine Baiting - Adjust burrow machine so that at least a teaspoonful size heap of WAY POCKET GOPHER BAIT is deposited at regular intervals in underground runway or tunnel so that each pocket gopher may receive a toxic dose at each bait placement. Observe WARNING notice above. Use rubber gloves to distribute this material.

ANTIDOTE: If less than 10 minutes has passed since the poison was taken, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Have victim lie down in a quiet, darkened room and keep him warm. Call a Physician Immediately!
