

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Convulsive Poison! Poisonous if Swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Keep away from children, pets and domestic animals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Clean clothing should be used daily.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Baits exposed on soil surface may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not expose baits in a manner which presents a likely hazard to pets, poultry and livestock.

Do not apply in gardens and areas where food and feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground. Collect and bury all dead animals found above ground. Do not apply by burrow builder under this label.

ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSIDERATIONS

NOTICE: The killing of a member of an endangered species during strychnine baiting operations may result in a fine under the Endangered Species Act. Before baiting, the user is advised to contact the Regional U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Endangered Species Specialist) or the local Fish and Game Office for specific information on endangered species. Strychnine baits should not be used in the geographic ranges of the following species except under programs and procedures approved by the USEPA: California condor, San Joaquin kit fox, Alcurian Canada goose, Morrow Bay kangaroo rat, gray wolf and grizzly bear.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If less than ten minutes has passed since poison was taken, give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Then have victim lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep warm.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Immediately remove contaminated clothing, INCLUDING SHOES, and wash skin with soap and plenty of water. If irritation develops, send for a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling. For control of the following pocket gophers:

Townsend (<i>Thomomys townsendii</i>)	Mountain (<i>Thomomys monticola</i>)
Northern (<i>Thomomys talpoides</i>)	Mazama (<i>Thomomys mazama</i>)
	Canas (<i>Thomomys talpoides</i>)

For use against pocket gophers on rangeland, pasture, cropland and nonagricultural sites subject to all Precautionary Statements and Use Restrictions on left panel.

HAND BAITING: Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan-shaped dirt mounds on either side of the underground burrow. These lateral burrows coming to the surface are open when the pocket gopher is active or plugged with soil. With a shovel and a long-handled spoon, carefully clean out a new opening or a newly plugged lateral runway down to the junction with main underground burrow. Insert a teaspoonful of bait at the junction with the main underground burrow. Reclose opening without covering bait with dirt.

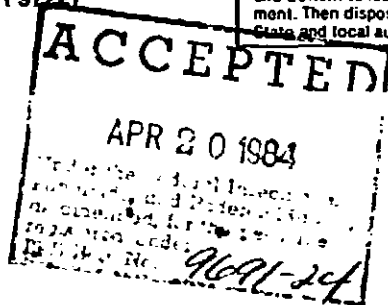
PROBING: Probe with a metal rod near active openings or mounds to locate main underground burrow. Enlarge probe hole to about 1" in diameter and drop teaspoonful of bait into burrow. Plug hole to exclude light without covering bait. Two baits per system should be adequate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store excess material in original labeled container in a cool dry area. Do not stack containers more than three high. Rotate containers end to end at least once a month. Keep containers away from children, pets and domestic animals. Avoid contamination of other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.
