PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION:

Convulsive Pocket Gopher Poisonous if Swallowed. Do not swallow bait. Do not consume food and liquids that have been handled by children, pets and domestic animals. Wash hands well with soap and water after handling and before eating or drinking. Clean clothing should be washed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product contains zinc and zinc bait is toxic to fish. Do not expose bait to surface water bodies such as ponds and streams. Do not apply a self-release stream in ponds, streams or lakes. Do not contaminate water by leaving bait open or exposed to water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For use against pocket gophers (Tomomys talpoides and Otospermophilus spp.) in lawns, golf courses and other non-crop areas. Do not expose bait in a manner which creates a likely hazard to pets, poultry, and livestock. Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground. Collect any living and dead critters found above ground.

HAND BAITING: Burrowing pocket gophers travel out law, fan-shaped mound, on either side of the underground burrow. These lateral burrows coming to the surface are open when the pocket gopher is active or are plugged with fresh soil. With a shovel and a long-handled scoop, carefully clear out a few inches of a newly plugged lateral runway close to the junction with the main underground burrow. Insert a teaspoon of bait at the junction with the main underground burrow. Replace opening without covering bait with dirt.

PALING: With a metal rod, probe near active mounds or "feeder" plugs to locate main underground runway. When runway has been found, soil resistance will decrease suddenly and the probe will drop about two-to-three inches. Enlarge opening to about one inch in diameter and drop one teaspoonful of bait into main tunnel. Plug hole to exclude light, taking care not to allow soil to cover bait. Bait each burrow system at two locations. Depending upon pocket gopher populations, one pound of bait will treat one-to-several acres.
