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**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Consult the Poison Prevention Department for information on the use of this product. Keep children and pets away from this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or drinking. Clean clothing should be washed daily.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other wildlife. Bait exposed to sunlight may become photo-toxic and other wildlife. Do not apply to waterways, streams, ponds, or other areas where fish or other wildlife are present.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For use against pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Caryacus* spp.) in lawns, golf courses and other non-cropland areas. Do not expose bait in a manner which presents a likely hazard to pets, poultry and livestock. Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground. Collect and bury all dead animals found above ground.

HAND BAITING: Burrowing pocket gophers tunnel out low, fan-shaped mounds on either side of the underground burrow. These lateral burrows coming to the surface are open when the pocket gopher is active or are plugged with fresh soil. With a shovel and a long-handled scoop, carefully clear out a new opening or a newly plugged lateral runway down to the junction with the main underground burrow. Insert a teaspoon of bait at the junction with the main underground burrow. Reclose opening without covering bait with dirt.

PROBING: With a metal rod, probe near active mounds or "feeder" plugs to locate main underground runways. When runway has been found, soil resistance will decrease suddenly and the probe will drop about two-to-three inches. Enlarge opening to about one inch in diameter and drop one teaspoonful of bait into main tunnel. Plug hole to exclude light, taking care not to allow soil to cover bait. Bait each burrow system at two locations. Depending upon pocket gopher populations, one round of bait will treat one-to-several acres.
