INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

EATING ESTABLISHMENTS, RESTAURANTS, & TAVERNS.

- (1) Scrape and pre-rinse utensils before washing.
- (2) Wash with a good detergent and hot water.
- (3) Rinse with clean hot water.
- (4) Sanitize by immersing in a 200 ppm. **GERM-O-RINSE** solution for 2 minutes or for the contact time specified by the governing code.
- (5) Air dry on clean drainboard or rack.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS; BAKERIES, CANNERIES, etc.

Clean wall and floors with a good detergent, rinse. Then spray with 800 ppm. **GERM-O-RINSE** solution. Clean equipment thoroughly with a good detergent, then sanitize by wiping or spraying with 400 ppm.

GERM-O-RINSE. Before direct contact with food, a rinse with clean running water is recommended.

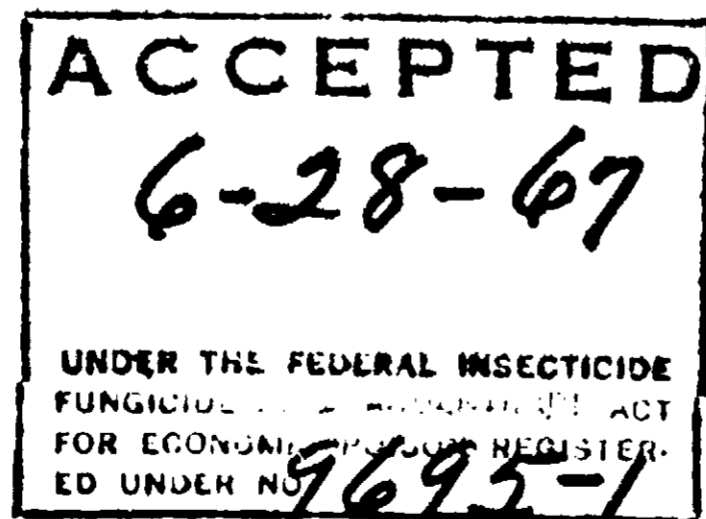
MILK FARMS AND MILK PROCESSING PLANTS. After equipment and utensils have been thoroughly cleaned; then sanitize with a 200 ppm. **GERM-O-RINSE** solution then rinse in clear running water and air dry.

HOSPITALS AND HOUSEHOLD USE. For the general disinfection of floors, walls, furniture, bath tubs, stall showers, toilets and etc., first clean with a good detergent. Then sanitize with 400 ppm. **GERM-O-RINSE.**

As a deodorant solution for waste containers, soiled materials or surfaces, use 1 to 2 ounces of **GERM-O-RINSE**, 10% to each gallon water.

Caution when soap or an anionic detergent is used for cleaning, rinse with water before sanitizing.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

SWIMMING POOLS: For Algae control use 1 gallon **GERM-O-RINSE** to each 50,000 gals. pool water (2½ oz. per 975 gals. of water) after first application add one quart of **GERM-O-RINSE** to each 50,000 gals. of water every 5 to 7 days depending on weather conditions. During sunny and humid periods more frequent additions may be required.

When Algae is seen in the pool pour 4 gals. **GERM-O-RINSE** into the pool for each 50,000 gals. of pool water. Allow to stand overnight. The loosened Algae should be removed (by vacuuming) and fresh water added to replace the water spent during cleaning. Then again treat the pool water 1 gal. **GERM-O-RINSE** for each 50,000 gals. of water and add **GERM-O-RINSE** as stated above to control Algae.

When used as directed **GERM-O-RINSE** will control Algae in swimming pools, but is intended to supplement, not replace, chlorination.

BARBER AND BEAUTY SHOPS. To disinfect instruments, utensils, and equipment, first cleanse thoroughly, then immerse, swab or spray with 1600 ppm. All implements used on patrons should be immersed in a solution of 1600 ppm. for at least 10 minutes.

Phenol Coefficient at 20°C Staph. Aureus — 75.
Salm. Typhosa — 50.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food. Dilute with water as directed.

Do not mix with soap.

DILUTION TABLE

Add 1.03 Ounce **GERM-O-RINSE** per

- 4 gal. water — 200 PPM Active Ingredient.
- 2 gal. water — 400 PPM Active Ingredient.
- 1 gal. water — 800 PPM Active Ingredient.
- ½ gal. water — 1600 PPM Active Ingredient.
