ALGICLEAR, when used as directed, will effectively prevent the growth of most common forms of algae in aquariums, ornamental fish ponds and fountains.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO TREAT AQUARIUM, POND OR TANK WATER

[FOR PRODUCT PACKAGED IN PLASTIC BOTTLES:]

Fill container half full of cool water and shake well. Add water to fill container. Shake well again and evenly distribute the mixture over the water to be treated. Use 1 tablespoon per 20 net gallons of water. Repeat treatment a week later for heavy algae growth or if algae reappears or is persistent.

[FOR PRODUCT PACKAGED IN PLASTIC POUCHES:]

One teaspoon ALGICLEAR treats approximately 600 gallons of water. Mix the correct dosage in a container of clear water. Shake or agitate thoroughly and evenly distribute the mixture over the water to be treated. Repeat treatment a week later for heavy algae growth, or if algae reappears or is persistent.

To calculate the water volume of a rectangular or square area, multiply (in feet) the length x width x average depth x 7.5. To calculate the water volume of an oval or round area, multiply (in feet) the length x width x average depth by 5.9.

If water is very dingy, best results will be achieved by scraping glass and renovating rocks, plants or other hard surfaces prior to treatment.

NOTE: Treatment may injure water hyacinths and water lilies.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, direct sunlight or open flames. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
