- 2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 9712-6".
 - b. Add an Environmental Hazards section to read as follows:

"Do not apply to or allow discharge to lakes, flowing water, or ponds with outflow. Do not contaminate domestic livestock or irrigation water supplies. Water treated with this product should not be used for human swimming or bathing activities."

c. Within the list of use sites for this product, restrict the uses on ornamental ponds and fountains to those with a maximum of 1,000 gallons in capacity.

- d. Revise the Disposal statement to read "Do not reuse container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."
- e. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"Causes eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

f. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

"IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

"IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention."

3. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

ALGICIDE, when used as directed, will effectively prevent the growth of most common forms of algae in aquariums, ornamental fish ponds and fountains.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Treats up to 80 gallons.

Initial Dosage: 1 tablespoon per 5 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dosage: Repeat dosage when algae reappears. One treatment normally lasts several weeks, depending on conditions causing algae. For heavy algae growth it may be necessary to repeat dosage within 6 days. Decayed algae should be loosened and wiped clean, and allow filter or vacuum system to remove residue. For best results, aquariums should be cleaned before application of ALGICIDE.

NOTE: Treatment may injure water hyacinths and water lilies.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or direct sunlight. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.
