

We are adding two words to the front panel: and Containerized. The State of New York classified this product as state restricted use because the fish ponds and fountains use sites could potentially flow into state waters – and only certified applicators are allowed to apply products to state waters. Therefore, by qualifying these sites as **containerized** fish ponds and fountains we will avoid the state waters issue and New York State will lift the restricted use designation.
