The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with PR Notices 98-10 and 2007-4 as an amendment is acceptable, provided you make the following change:

1. Please add "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact other persons or pets either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application." This should be located in the "Directions for Use" section under the heading "General Precautions and Restrictions".

A stamped copy of your label is enclosed for your records. This label supersedes all previously accepted labels. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after eighteen (18) months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA §6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Shake Well Before Using

Clean aquariums, fish ponds and fountains before application.

Initial Dosage: 1 teaspoon per 15 gallons of water [1 tablespoon per 45 gallons of water] [8 fl. oz. (1 cup) per 720 gallons of water].

Maintenance Dosage: Repeat dosage when algae reappears. One treatment normally lasts several weeks, depending on algae-causing conditions. For heavy algae growth repeat dosage within 6 days. Loosen and wipe clean decayed algae, and allow filter or vacuum system to remove residue.

Note: Treatment may injure water hyacinths and water lilies.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place, inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or direct sunlight. **Container Disposal:** Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
