**INGREDIENTS**

Condensed corn, soybean meal, ground grain sorghum, salt, calcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, iron sulfate, 15% dried, dehydrated vegetable, dehydrated alfalfa meal, Vitamin A palmitate, stability improved, citric acid, potassium salt carbonate.

**CAUTION: This feed should be used only in accordance with feeding directions listed below. Do not feed to lactating dairy animals. Occasional sensitivity of phenothiazine has been reported in cattle.**

**FEEDING DIRECTIONS**

This feed contains 1% of the active ingredient. It should be fed at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 lbs. of live weight for cattle and 1/2 lb. per 100 lbs. for sheep and goats. Cattle should receive approximately 1/2 lb. of Fly Block per 100 lbs. of live weight daily for maximum protection. For sheep and goats, the rate should be 1/4 lb. per 100 lbs. of live weight daily. The effective life of the Fly Block is approximately 30 days per pound of feed. The animal should receive the effective ingredient throughout the entire life of the animal. Provide adequate quantities of water. For maximum protection against fly attack, distribute the Fly Block when first starting a new animal feeding program with a new lot of animals. Even though you are not breeding, it is important that you feed Fly Block to your animals to prevent fly attacks. If feeding programs of this type are not followed, the Fly Block will not usually be necessary. Some fly infestations may be so severe that the Fly Block will not be sufficient to control them.
