Recommended Dilutions

After cleaning, 1 oz. Septical to 4 gallons of water for sanitizing

Milking Machines Milk Cans
Dishes, Glasses, Cutlery
Food Processing Equipment
Rinse with potable water after sanitizing- just before the equipment is to be used.

After cleaning, 1 oz. Septical to 2 gallons of water for disinfecting floors, walls, and surfaces, etc., as found in hospitals, institutions, homes, industrial areas, public rooms, conveyances, etc.

After cleaning, 2 1/2 oz. Septical to 2 gallons of water for cold disinfection of Surgical instruments, barber shop and beauty parlor equipment. For surgical instruments, it is advisable to add 1 tablespoon of sodium nitrate per gallon of solution as a corrosion inhibitor.
