DISINFECTANT CLEANER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO REMOVE HEAVY DIRT:

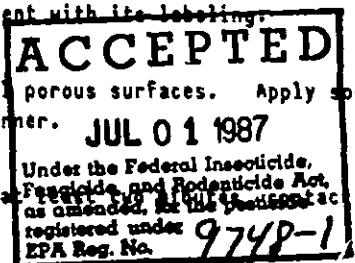
Use up to 6 ounces per gallon of water on heavily soiled hard surfaces, same on all porous surfaces. Apply solution; let stand a few minutes or scrub if needed. Pick up and rinse in usual manner.

TO DEODORIZE:

Use one ounce per gallon of water. Apply to previously cleaned surface and allow to air-dry. Pick up in usual manner or allow to air-dry.

TO DISINFECT:

Use 2 ounces per gallon of water on previously cleaned, hard surfaces such as floors. Apply solution so that surface is thoroughly wet. Allow at least 10 minutes contact. Pick up in usual manner or allow to air-dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
