### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not to be used in any recreational areas or in or around homes.

Prepare and apply as follows: Dilute 1 gallon of TRI-KIL with up to 10 gallons of water, and apply as a wet spray on 250 to 300 sq. ft. of soil surface. TRI-KIL may be applied if desired without further dilution. Apply at the rate of 1/4 to 1/2 gallon per 100 sq. ft. For control of perennial grasses and broad weeds, the heavier rates are suggested. For control of annual weeds, apply TRI-KIL as a contact spray when plants are young, thoroughly wetting all parts of the plants, particularly the growing tips. For control of perennial grasses, such as Johnson grass, late summer or fall applications are recommended. Do not apply TRI-KIL sprays on desirable plants or over the root area of desirable trees or shrubs. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants. (CALIFORNIA ONLY, DO NOT APPLY TO MORE THAN ONE ACRE PER DAY.)

## ENTRY RESTRICTIONS

Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
