CAUTION

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED: Avoid prolonged breathing of spray mist. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not contaminate food or feed products. Food utensils such as teaspoons and tablespoons should not be used for food purposes after use with insecticides.

Do not allow contact with treated surfaces until sprays have dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in areas near the application site. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Use only outdoors in strict accordance with label cautions, warnings, and directions.

FLY CONTROL: Mix 1 gallon Malathion Spray Concentrate to 9 gallons of water (1/4 pint per gallon) and apply as below.

Baited Spray: To attract flies and prolonged effectiveness, use 10 pounds of sugar or 1 gallon syrup or unsulfurized molasses per 50 gallons of diluted mix (1 cup sugar or syrup per gallon).

Apply one quart per 250 sq. ft. of painted surface or 2 quarts if unpainted. Treat areas where flies rest or congregate such as outside of buildings, walls, door and window frames of jams, garbage cans, and other structures.

MOSQUITO AND SMALL INSECTS: Outdoors use a 2-3% fog, aerosol or space spray. Dilute 1 part Malathion Spray Concentrate in 4-5 parts water, fuel oil or diesel oil. Direct fog or aerosol to areas where insects are a problem.

For 5% fog, dilute one part Malathion Spray Concentrate to one part of water. Mosquito Larvae (in standing water): Apply at a rate of 2 quarts per acre (1/2 pound actual Malathion per acre).

FIRST AID:

READ LABEL BEFORE SPRAYING

Mix in sufficient water or oil for good coverage. Broadcast use only over intermittently flooded areas. Applications may not be made around bodies of water where fish or shellfish are grown and/or harvested commercially.

SPOT TREATMENT: Dilute one part to 20 parts water (1/2 pint per gallon) and apply.

HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: Outdoors (Roaches, Ants, Crickets, Spiders, Silverfish, Earwigs, Carpet Beetles, Clothes Moths, Bedbugs): Mix 1/2 pint in one quart of water (1 quart per gallon) or for oil base spray mix 1 part Malathion Spray Concentrate with 2 parts deodorized kerosene solution. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush or low pressure spray to areas where insects run or hide as window sills, under eaves, along foundations and other areas frequented by these pests.

ORNAMENTALS, SHRUBS, SHADE TREES: Aphids, Spider Mites, White Fly, Mailbags, Thrips, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Leafhoppers, Oystershell Scale, Scurfy Scale: Use one gallon to 100 gallons of water (1 1/4 oz. to one gallon of water). Soft Brown Scale, Monterey Pine Scale, Black Scale, Juniper Scales: 1 1/2 gallons to 100 gallons water (2 oz. to one gallon water). Leaf Miner: 1 1/4 gallons to 100 gallons water (1 3/4 oz. to one gallon water).

CITRUS (Grapefruit and Oranges), California Red Scales, Yellow Scales, Purple Scales, Black Scales, Soft Scales, Citricola Scales, Thrips: 2oz to one gallon water. Do not apply for a period of 7 days prior to harvest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place. Keep container closed. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
