

For deep rooted weeds and grasses such as Bermuda, Johnson, Bindweed and Quack grass, the heavier rate (a lower dilution 1 gal. to 5 gal. of water per 200 square feet) is recommended. Retreatments may be necessary to secure adequate control of certain hard-to-kill weeds.
