DIRECTIONS

TO CONTROL FLYING INSECTS BY SPACE SPRAYING: To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, close all openings and turn off air-conditioning and ventilating systems. Cover all foods, and remove those foods whose taste or flavor may be affected by the spray. Use an electric sprayer for best results, with the spray nozzle adjusted to produce a fine cloud mist. For optimum kill, spray about 2 minutes for each 50,000 cubic feet of space. Leave room closed for about 10 minutes after spraying.

TO CONTROL CRAWLING INSECTS BY SURFACE SPRAYING: To kill roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, and spiders, use a coarse, wet spray especially in cracks and crevices. Spray shelf areas of cupboards, lockers, and other places which may harbor insects. Be sure the sprayed surface is thoroughly wetted. Do not spray on food or cooking utensils.

IN-CIDE is also effective against the exposed stages of grain weevils, grain moths, flour beetles and grain mites. IN-CIDE kills ants, fleas and ticks, bedbugs, and carpet beetles. For grain insects, wet surface thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect hiding places, and runways. Spray all places of entry to control ants. To control fleas and brown dog ticks, spray lower portions of wall, baseboards, rugs, carpets, and floors. Animal quarters, bedding, and kennels should be sprayed also. Spray beds and mattresses to control bedbugs and air bedding before using. Spray infested areas of carpets, floors, baseboards, and under carpets to control carpet beetles.

IN-CIDE meets requirements of the "Meat Inspection Division Memorandum No. 52—Insect Sprays." Provided exposed meats should first be removed before spraying and the premises should be cleaned by thorough washing after completion of the application in meat inspection establishments.
