sTORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store this product in a cool, dry area many from direct surlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of a spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Products or rineates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a senilary sewer. Do not reuse container, but place in treat collection. Do not contaminated food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

NING POOL WATER DISINFECTION: For a new pool or spring start-up, superchloringto with 46 to 95 ce, of product for each 10,000 gallons of water to yield 5 to 10 ppm available chloring by weight. Check the level of evallable chloring with a test left. Adjust and resintain the pool water pH to between 7.2 and 7.6. Adjust and maintain the aliability of the pool to between 50 and 100 ppm.
