TO SANITIZE:

Use a solution of 1 ounce of T-CHEM Iodine Sanitizer (iodine) to sanitize. Equipment should be thoroughly cleaned for at least 2 minutes in the solution. Drain thoroughly and

If a concentration in excess of 25 ppm titratable iodine is used on equipment a final potable water rinse must be made

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard

NOTE: Use fresh solution for each milking. Where milking is done twice-a-day, follow above method each time. Follow instructions for covering cleaning and sanitization.
