WORK SAFETY RULES

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital -immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to methyl parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given (see First Aid Treatment Section) and if a doctor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with scap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower, using soap and water, Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.

(POISON SIGNS (Symptoms) &

Methyl parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: Headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin-point pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to methyl parathion and describe his condition.

IF BREATHING HAS STOPPED, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor

IF SWALLOWED and victim is awake (conscious) make him vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving soapy or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious persori. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

IN CASE OF CONTACT, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidote - administer alropine suffate in large doses. TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear, 2-PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine D5 NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Methyl parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edma, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after initial improvement; VERY CLOSE SUPERVI-SION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.





GENERAL INFORMATION

RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 is useful for the control of certain insect pests of cotton, alfalfa, certain small grains (barley, oats, rye, wheat), and soybeans.

RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 may be applied by ground sprayers or by airplanes, mixing the RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 in water to form an emulsion spray solution. To make the spray solution, half fill the spray tank with water, agitate, add the proper amount of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4, and then fill the spray tank with water while still agitating. Continue to agitate during use.

When applying with ground sprayers calibrate so as to apply the recommended amount of RIVERSIDE METHYL FARATHION 4 in not less than 3 gations of water per acre. Airplanes should apply the recommended amount of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 in 3 to 10 gallons of water per acre. Always use sufficient water for adequate coverage of the crop foliage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COTTON — When applying RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 by ground sprayers to cotton use as follows.

Early Season — For control of Aphids, Thrips, and Red Spider Miles make two to three applications of 1 pint of R VEFSICE METHYL PARATHION 4 per acre per accideation, starting when the lotten comes to a stand or when inspection shows these insects to be present.

Mid-Season — Start Mid-Season at plications when the cotton starts squaring. Apply 1 pint of RIVERSIDE METHYL, FARATHION 4 per acre per application for control of Aphids. Boll Weevis Fleahoppers. Rapid and Tarnished Plant Buga, and Red Spider Mites, making four or five applications at weekly intervals. Lafe-Season — Start treatments wien Boll Weevit intestations reach 10% or more or when intestations of other Jamaging insects controlled by RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 are notiged. Apply 1 to 2 pints of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 depending upon the severity of the intestation at 3 to 4 day intervals until the infestation is brought under control. Late season insects controlled by 1 to 2 pints of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 per acre include Boll Weevit, Cotton Leavorm, Fleahoppers, and Red Spider Mies. For control of the Bollworm apply i cuart of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 per acre per application at 3 to 4 day intervals until the infestation is brought under control.

When applying RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 by airplane make the applications on the same timing schedule as for ground machine applications, but always apply the amounts given for Late-Season applications.

Do not apply RIVERSIDE METAY PARATHION 4 within 7 days of hand picking or harvest. Workers entered cotton fields within 24 hours after application of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 should wear protective clothing

ALFALFA — For control of the Statted Alfalfa Aphid apply ½ to 1 pint of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHICS 4 per acre per application, depending upon the height of the alfalfa and systemy of the infestation.

For control of Leafhoppers, Arguages (up to 3rd instar), and Mites, apply 1¼ quarts of RIVERSIDE METHOL PARATHION 4 per acre per application.

For control of Affalfa Weevil Larvae apply 1½ pints of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 per acre when affalfa buds and shoots first appear ragged or when larvae count reaches 25 per sweep.

Do not apply RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 to alfalfa later than 20 days before harvesting or grazing.

SMALL GRAINS — (Barley, Oats, Rye, Wheat) — For control of Aphids (Green Bug) apply ½ to 1 pint per acre per application, depending upon the severity of the infestation. For control of Armyworms (up to 3rd instar) and Leafhoppers apply 1½ pints of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 per acre per application.

Do not apply RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 to small grains later than 15 days prior to harvest.

SOYBEANS — For control of Stink Bugs, Three-Cornered Alfalfa Hopper, and Velvet Bean Caterpillar apply 1 to 1.5 pints of RIVERSIDE METHYL PARA-THION 4 per acre.

Do not apply RIVERSIDE METHYL PARATHION 4 to soybeans later than 20 days prior to harvest. Do not apply more than two applications per growing season.

DISPOSAL OF CONTAINER AND WASTES

This container should not be reused for ANY purpose. When empty, it should be rendered uscless by punching large holes in the top, bottom, and sides with an instrument such as an axe. It should then be mashed as that as possible and buried underground as deep as practical, with at least 18 inches of soil covering. This should be done in an isolated area, away from habitation, and in a location which would not drain into, or cause pollution of takes, streams, or ponds. Any spray wastes or spillage resulting from the application of this material or the destruction of the container should be neutralized with a caustic solution and buried in a pit with the disposed container.
