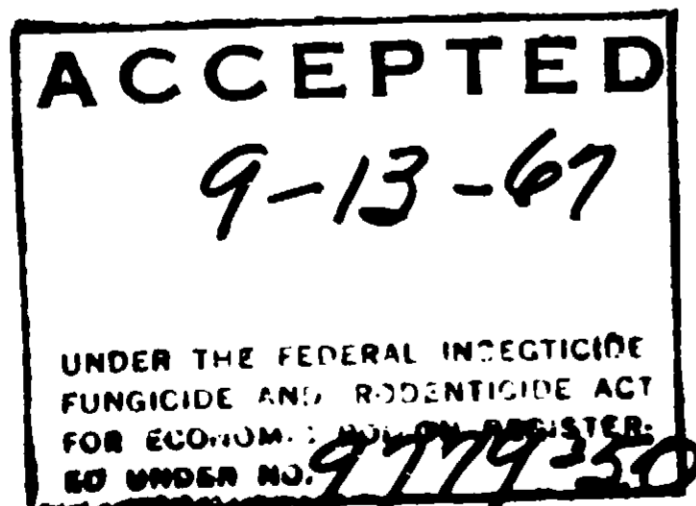
When dusting for Mexican Bean Beetles, dust the under-
