GENERAL: Ants nesting out-doors may be found in anthills or mounds, tree trunks, under stones or timber, and next to foundation walls.

RECOMMENDATIONS

ANTS IN GARDEN: Injury to plants in vegetable gardens are often caused by ants. They injure plants directly by feeding or cause injury by destroying vegetation around their nests. For garden control, treat soil of the entire infested area-usually a minimum of 4 oz. of 10% Chlordane is required for each 100 sq. feet. Chlordane soil treatment is limited to preplanting, planting or transplanting treatment.

It may be used where the following crops are to be grown: Beans, beets, blackeye peas, cabbage, corn, cucumbers, egg plant, lettuce, okra, peppers, radishes, squash, tomatoes, turnips, and watermelons.

Do not dust the vegetable plant or other food crops. Do not treat soil around vegetable crops after the edible parts begin to form.

ANTS IN TREES AND SHRUBS: Wounds of various kinds, especially decayed stubs of limbs are points of entrance used by ants. For controlling ants in trees and shrubs, dust the trunk of the tree or shrub and the soil under the plant with a minimum of 4 oz. of 10% Chlordane dust for each 100 sq. feet. Do not use on fruit trees or in orchards.

YARDS AND LAWNS:

Ant: Fire ants, black ants, pavement ants, and argintina ants generally nest in open and are frequently found infesting lawns and yards. The lawn and yard control recommendation is 4 oz. of 10% Chlordane per 100 sq. feet. Do not use on fruit trees or in orchards.

SOD WEBWORMS: Use 2 oz. of 10% Chlordane dust for each 100 sq. feet of infested area. Apply in late afternoon. A second application may be needed.

CHIGGERS, FLEAS, AND TICKS: Use 8 oz. of 10% Chlordane dust for each 1,000 sq. feet to be treated. Do not apply insecticides to lawns or other turf areas where people or animals are on them. Do not allow

insecticide to drift to areas where they might injure people or animals or contaminate food or feed. Keep children and pets off treated lawns or other turf areas until the insecticide has been washed off by sprinkling and the grass has completely dried.

CAUTION: Could be fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid breathing dust. Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of spray from areas treated. Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by punching holes in them and burying with wastes.

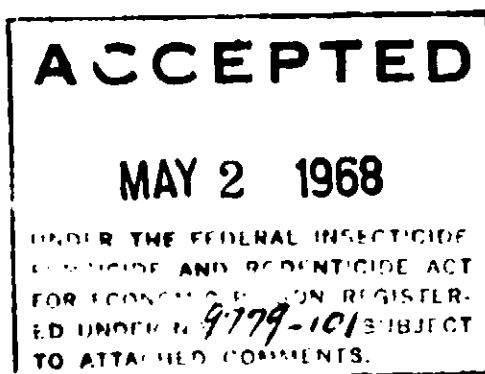

For the control in grasses and lawns of: Ants, Chinese bugs, Japanese beetle, European chafin, and white grubs, use 10 ounces of 40% WP per 1,000 square feet. To control army worms, cutworms, mole crickets, god web worms, and wire worms, use 5 ounces of 40% WP per 1,000 square feet. For the control in flowers of: Ants, use 2 tablespoons per 3 gallons or 30 square feet. Wire worm, white grubs, and other beetles use 5 ounces of 40% WP in enough water to cover 1,000 square feet. Treat when damage or insects are noticed.

A second application may be needed to control chinch bug.

For the control of ticks and chiggers in outside areas, use 5 pounds per acre. Spray every 4 to 6 weeks or as needed.

Do not apply insecticides to lawns or other turf areas when people or animals are on them, and do not allow insecticides to drift to areas where they might injure people or animals or contaminate food or feed.

Keep children and pets off treated lawns and other turf areas until the insecticide has been washed off by sprinkling and the grass completely dries.

CAUTION: Careful if swallowed. This solution, if brought into repeated or prolonged contact with skin, can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid inhalation and skin contact. In case of spillage on the skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Avoid contamination of fur, clothes, or household pets.
