NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS

Apply only 1 application of Boron-Copper-Sulphur per uear to supply the boron needed to reduce hollow heart in peanuts. Use instead of one of the usual four fungicidal applications. Other fungicidal dusts applied at about 10 day intervals, the first dusting should be about the time of last cultivation.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL

From 20 to 30 pounds of dust per acre depending on size of plants.

CAUTION

Harmful if taken internally. If taken internally, induce vomiting by giving mustard and water and tickling the throat. Give large dosed of magnesia or lime water, followed with doses of Epsom Salts.
