If SEVIN Insecticide is used in accordance with label directions, these crops, including corn forage and rice straw, may be grazed or harvested for use as feed for dairy and meat animals without resulting in residues in milk or meat.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use on corn and rice: Recommended dosages refer to pounds of Riverside 5% GRANULAR SEVIN INSECTICIDE per acre. Use suitable ground or air equipment to insure good coverage. Apply when pests appear in damaging numbers and repeat 7 to 14 days later if necessary.

### CORN:

Use 30 to 40 pounds for first-generation European corn borer larvae in whorls. No post-treatment time limitations on applications to sweet corn and corn forage and fodder.

### RICE:

In California, use 40 pounds for tadpole shrimp. For optimum control, apply to water when pest first appears. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

WARNING: To avoid plant injury, do not apply within 15 days of propanil (such as Riverside's "Propanilo", or "Stam") use.

### LAWNS:

For control of chinch bugs and certain other insects cut the lawn close, remove clippings and water before treatment to bring chinch bugs to the surface.

Treat the entire lawn evenly and thoroughly at the rate of 4 pounds of RIVERSIDE 5% SEVIN GRANULAR INSECTICIDE per 1000 square feet. Apply with a spreader for uniform coverage. Work material in with a coarse water spray after treatment. RIVERSIDE 5% SEVIN GRANULAR INSECTICIDE will aid in the control of fall armyworms, sod webworms or lawn moths, ants and millipedes.

### CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Burn immediately when empty. Stay out of smoke.
