If Swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

Refer to the proposed 40 Code of Federal Regulations. Part 156 published in the *Federal Register* on September 26, 1984 on page 37982.

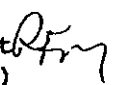
d. In the Environmental Hazard section delete the sentence:

Do not apply directly to water.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
